## IMC's new Collierville HQ involves \$23M investment and 100-plus jobs

One of Memphis' largest logistics firms is pouring in millions of dollars and creating more than 100 jobs as part of its Collierville expansion project.

Department of Economic & Community Development, and IMC Companies — the biggest intermodal firm in Memphis — announced Oct. 6 that the company is investing \$23 million to expand its Shelby County headquarters operations and produce 158 new jobs in Collierville. According to IMC, the timeframe of the jobs creation is over the next five years.

IMC's current base is located at 3150 Lenox Park Blvd. in Memphis, but the firm is constructing a new 75,000-square-foot corporate

headquarters at 1305 Schilling Blvd. West in Collierville, which will be ready in late November.

In March, the total cost of the facility was estimated at \$18.3 million. IMC told MBJ that the difference in cost from initial figure to a now-\$23 million investment is due to the firm choosing to build out areas that were not originally planned for the HQ.

IMC is a key gear in the international supply chain industry. The company has grown to provide services that include drayage, expedited services, warehousing, chassis provisioning, and secured container storage. IMC has nearly 50 locations across the country, along with more than 2,200 drivers and trucks across the U.S. The firm also has over 12,000 containers and chassis in its depots and moves more than one million 20-foot equivalent units (TEUs) annually.

Locally, IMC employs more than 500 and has more than 2,300 total staff companywide. In 2020, IMC had \$450.5 million in gross revenue, according to MBJ research, which ranked as the No. 19 largest locally based private company. IMC moved approximately 130,000 intermodal containers in 2020, ranking No. 1 in the Memphis metro.

The IMC national family of brands includes DNJ Intermodal Services (DNJ); Gulf Intermodal Services (GIS); H&M Intermodal; Intermodal Cartage Co. (IMCG); Ohio Intermodal Services (OIS); Pacific Drayage Services (PDS); and Atlantic Intermodal Services (AIS).
