On Saturday, Aug. 29, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., GREG AKERS I the delivery services giant will look to fill 500 permanent, part-time positions at the FedEx World Hub.

Interested applicants must be 18 years old, able to lift 50 pounds, and have lived in the U.S. for five years. There is no minimum educational requirement, but those who apply will be subject to a criminal background check and drug screen. Job fair attendees need to bring two valid forms of ID.

FedEx Express isn't the delivery service giant's only business segment hiring.

Since the start of the pandemic, FedEx Ground has reportedly hired "tens of thousands" of package handlers and service providers, as e-commerce booms and it hustles to keep up with demand.

Between late June and early July, the company announced more than 7,900 open positions around the country, according to *MBJ* research.
